



2020 Medicaid PCMH High-priority Beneficiary Selection

Medicaid PCMH has heard your concern about having limited time to select HPBs. Medicaid will make the following efforts to address this issue:

1. Provide each PCMH with 2020 attribution in the February PHMR Report

This will allow you, as providers, to begin the selection a month earlier than previous years.

This PHMR will also provide indicators to show if the beneficiary had been selected by you or another provider as an HPB in 2019.

This indicator is very important because AHIN no longer shows previous years' HPB selection.

This special report will be uploaded to AHIN for your viewing tomorrow, February 13, 2020. Please note – you cannot make your HPB selection in AHIN. You will receive notification when the AHIN portal is open for 2020 HPB selection.

2. Provide attribution on AHIN by March 1, 2020

This will allow you to transfer your selection and give you a whole month to review your selections.

3. The ability to select five additional HPBs based off March's PHMR attribution

The attribution to select HPBs is from the Point In Time (PIT) enrollment attribution of 1/2/2020.

We understand that there may be a few beneficiaries that you begin seeing after this date that you feel should be an HPB.

Medicaid will allow you to select up to five additional beneficiaries per PCMH as HPBs, if you choose.

These beneficiaries will be an addition to the 10% and will not replace any HPBs you choose from attribution on AHIN. Instructions for this process will be provided in the near future.

The HPB flag will no longer follow a beneficiary if they fall off attribution.
