

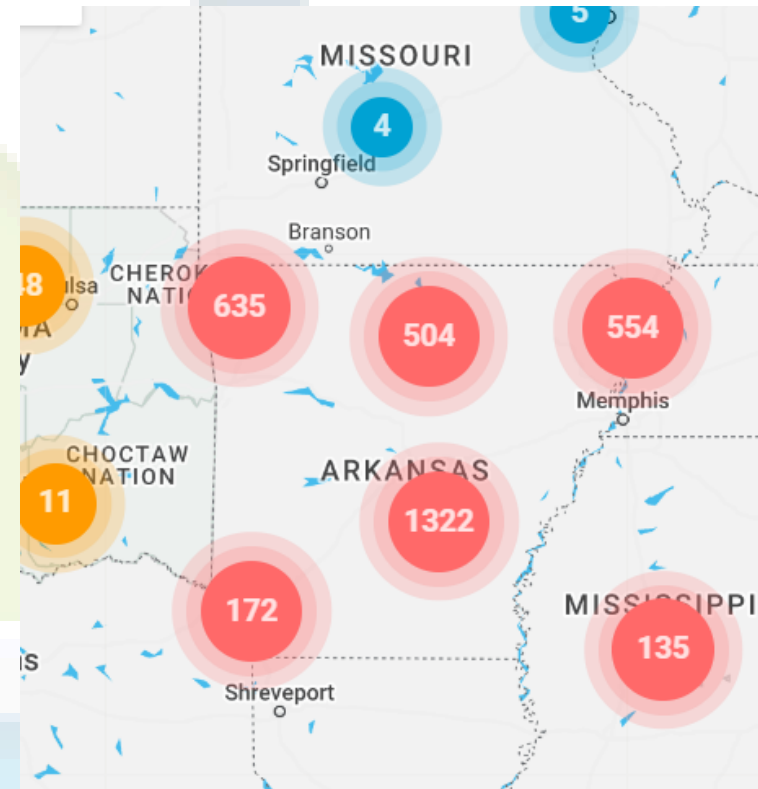

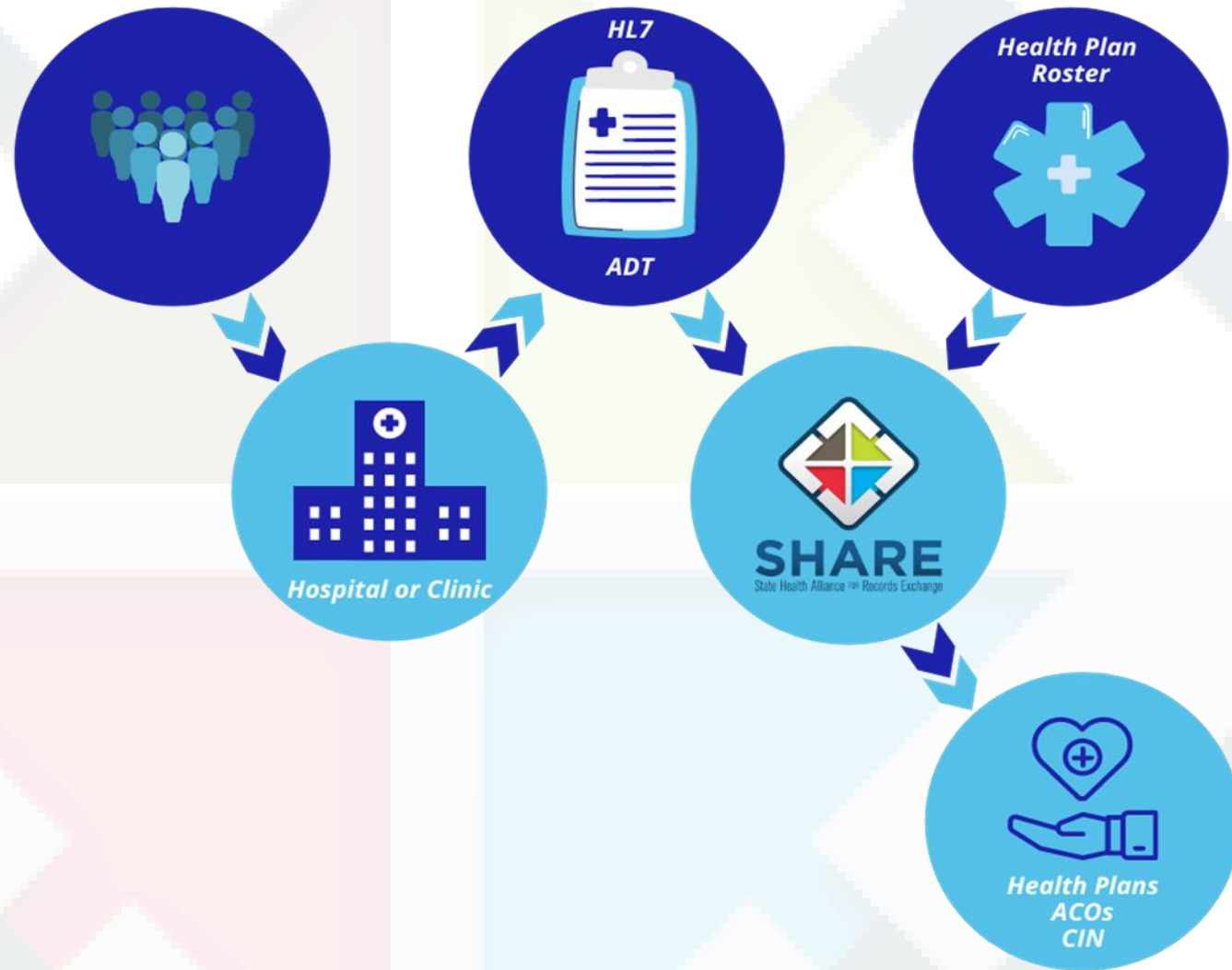

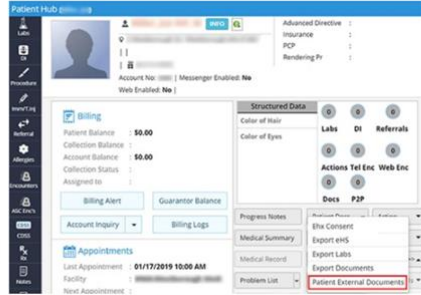
To request a patient's eHS:

1. On the patient's Progress Notes window, click the *Patient External Documents* link:



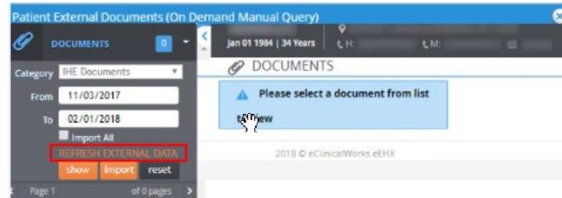

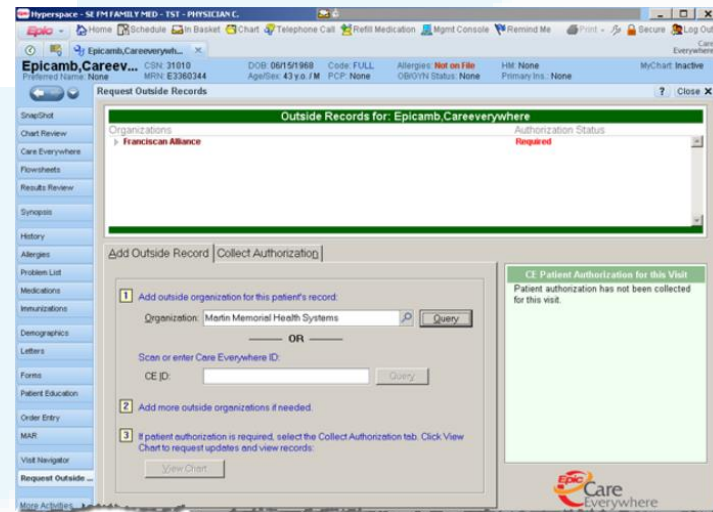
